- Council Directive 2008/106/EC, as amended;

Declares :

That the "Fast Rescue Boat Refresher" training of D.H.T.C. B.V. at their location in Den Helder, the Netherlands, has been approved under course ID : FRB-R, the contents, method of instruction and the evaluation of each candidate being in accordance with the minimum requirements set out in the STCW Code. The duration of the course is 7 hours on the clock.

- In case the approved training course is amended in any way whatsoever during the validity of this certificate, the training course shall be re-assessed by the Netherlands Shipping Inspectorate before the amended training course is conducted;
